- 3. What are specific ways you can keep God at the center of the ministries you serve in so that they don't become just a social club?
- 4. Review the 5 remedies for the church in Sardis. How might you share these remedies with a friend whose spiritual pulse is weak/flatlining?
- 5. What have you been taught about the Lamb's Book of Life prior to today? What other passages speak of this book?
- 6. Review the bulletin insert, "Dead and Living Churches" by Charles Swindoll. What are two practical things you can do this week to be a part of the solution in helping keep our church from spiritually flatlining?

September Financial Update

September's General Fund Income of \$25,853 was \$4,293 under budget. However, this is not a problem due to the very high income we received in August. For September, our General Fund had a deficit of \$4,088, but for the first three months of our fiscal year we have a large surplus of \$37,442. This should allow us to begin building a reserve to handle unexpected building repairs, which is one of our goals for this fiscal year.

With the excellent balance in our General Fund, we can direct giving in

the final months of 2024 to Other Funds, such as our Christmas White Gift Project, Furnishings Fund (to develop our kitchen), Refugee Sponsorship and Prairie College Bursary, knowing that our general operations will not suffer as we do so. Thank you for your commitment to God shown by your gifts to PTC.
